WHAT'S NEEDED TO COMPLETE FAFSA

STUDENTS:

- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration or Permanent Resident Card (if not a U.S. citizen)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- 2018 Federal Income Tax Returns, W2s and other records of money earned
 - You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool
- Current bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income and child support received (if applicable)
- FSA ID to sign electronically

PARENTS: (In addition to the above, bring the following if applicable)

- Child support received
- Information about assets: Savings, CDs, stock options, bonds, 529 Plans or other college savings plans, investment real estate, businesses or farms
